Community Thread provides transportation to medical and nonmedical appointments with the help of volunteers in its Thrive program. This service is for ambulatory riders who live in the Stillwater School District (ISD 834). First-time riders need to complete a pre-service application form prior to start of service.

Hours of service: Monday through Friday.

8 a.m. to 4 p.m. (no holidays)

Times may vary depending on the availability of volunteer drivers and the distance to and from appointment.

Call during office hours: Monday through

Friday, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Advance notice required: After the initial application is complete, requests must be made at least 3 days prior to an appointment.

Wheelchair lift: No.

Price: Rides may be free with Thrive membership. Memberships are available at free or reduced prices for those who qualify. Non-member medical rides are \$25/roundtrip. Call for details.

Advance notice required: Reserve a ride up

to 5 days in advance. There is limited same day service with minimum of 2 hours advance notice.

Wheelchair lift: Yes.

Price: Peak \$4.50 M-F 6 to 9 a.m. or 3 to 6:30 p.m.; Off-Peak \$3.50; Holidays all day \$3.50 (includes Memorial Day, Independence Day, Friday after Thanksgiving)
Trips that are over 15 miles subject to an additional \$.75 surcharge.

Children age 5 and under ride free; up to 4 children can ride free.

If your vehicle arrives more than 1 hour after the scheduled pickup time, your trip is free.

Exact change is required, or Go Cards may be purchased from Cub Foods stores. Pick-ups may be up to 30 minutes later than requested, depending on circumstances of previous pick-ups of the other bus riders. Drivers will wait up to 3 minutes for riders to appear.
